READ THE RATINGS. PLACE WITH CONFIDENCE.

One consistent key for product comparison, maturity timing and disease-response ratings.

THE 1-9 SCALE

For every scored trait, a higher number is more favorable.

9

BEST END

Top of the published scale.

7-8

STRONG

A meaningful strength for placement.

5-6

MODERATE

Serviceable; manage around the field risk.

3-4

WATCH

Placement or management sensitivity.

1-2

WEAK END

Lowest end of the published scale.

Half-point ratings such as 7.5 or 8.5 indicate performance between whole-number classes.

MATURITY USES A DIFFERENT SCALE

Lower or negative values indicate earlier relative timing; higher or positive values indicate later timing within the same source system.

Do not read maturity as a guaranteed calendar date or as part of the 1-9 rating scale.

Fhb1 VERIFIED

The source breeder confirmed the marker. It strengthens the FHB base; it does not mean immunity or replace flowering-time risk management.

A simple four-digit structure makes introduction year, maturity class and head type immediately readable.

The G is the authentic monogram - the four digits are the product identity.

PUBLIC IDENTITY RULE

Use the exact G monogram + four digits. No W. No typed G. No Jo-Mar number on customer-facing materials.

The number identifies the variety; the tech sheet still determines disease fit, standability, yield proof and management placement.
